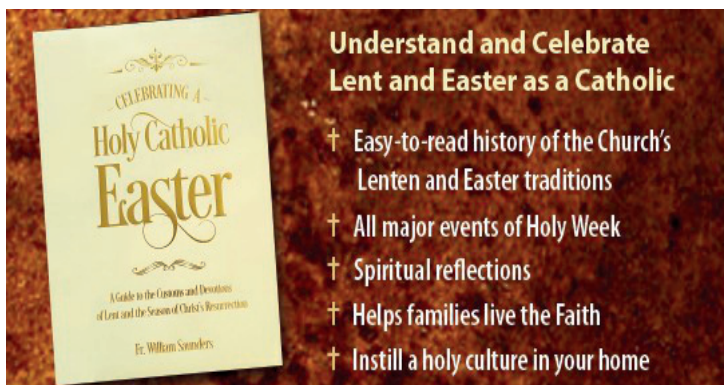
Watch the Livestream of the Ordination to the Priesthood
