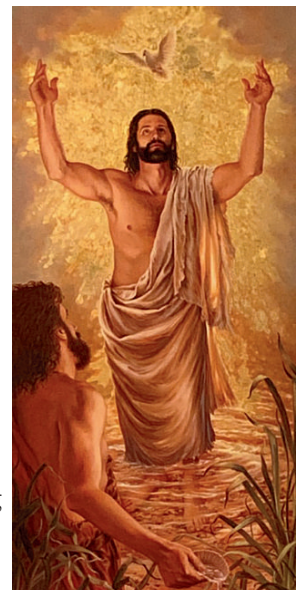
Inquiry Class

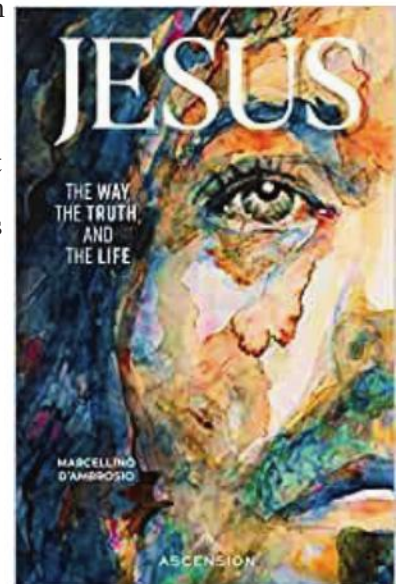
