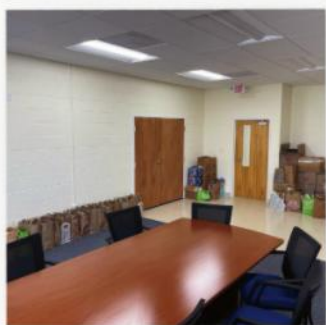
Suffering after Divorce?

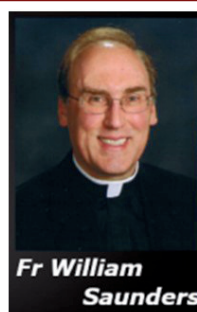
