He enrolled in the engineering program at Virginia Tech University in Blacksburg. After two years, he transferred to the Franciscan University of Steubenville, Ohio, where he graduated with a bachelor's degree in philosophy. After graduating from Franciscan, he enrolled in Catholic University's Theological College in Washington, DC, for his six years of Seminary.

He came to St. Agnes as a seminarian in 2013, was ordained a deacon in 2014, and continued to serve at St. Agnes until his ordination on June 6, 2015. His first assignment was at the Basilica of Saint Mary in Alexandria where he stayed until 2019 when he was assigned to Saint Louis Parish in Alexandria.




