Dear Parishioners:

On the reverse side of this letter you will see a summary report of our financial statements for the last fiscal year, July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022. This summary report is based on the complete report sent to the Finance Office of the Diocese of Arlington. Also, our independent accountant and our Parish Finance Council have reviewed all the parts of the report.

Last fiscal year, we did end with a new operating surplus for both the church and the school. Please keep in mind, because of that surplus, we were able to undertake additional projects that were outside the scope of the church and school renovations, including

New glass block windows for the school gymnasium, A new concrete entryway to the gym with proper handicap accessibility, A new floor for the gym (with the help of the PTO), Landscaping, Repaving the parking lots, A new concrete entryway to the side entrance of the church with proper handicap accessibility, and Renovations to the parish hall, meeting rooms, and bathrooms.

This fiscal year, we will bring to completion the major renovations on the church and the old convent. We borrowed \$3 million from the Diocese, which we will be amortizing over ten years. While the project as whole cost slightly over \$9 million, more money had to be spent from our operating revenues to cover the 3% surcharge for contract management by the Office of Planning, Construction, and Facilities, amounting to \$250,000.

Therefore, I thank you for your generosity shown through our regular offertory donations and the capital campaign. Given the mortgage, any extra contribution for "Debt Reduction" (listed in both the envelopes and Faith Direct) will truly be appreciated.

Please be assured of my prayers.
