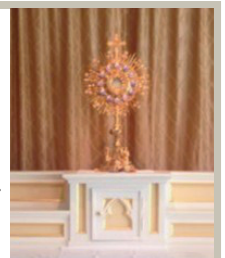
Adorers Needed!

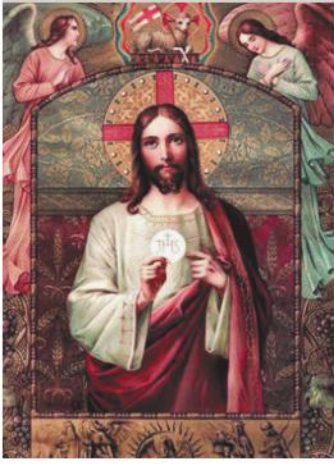

Advent Days of Recollection for Discerners Dec. 16 and 17

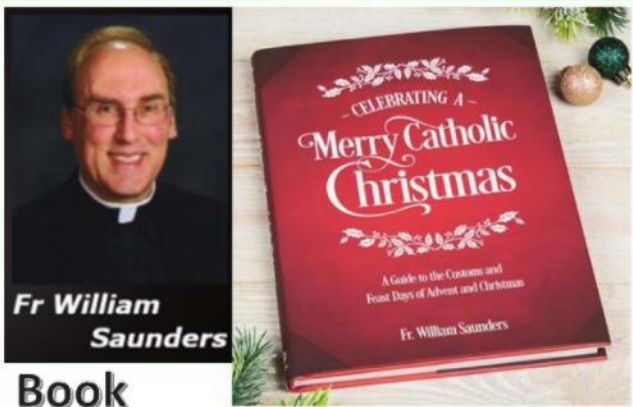

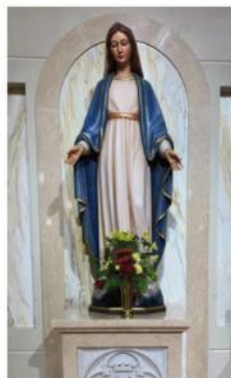

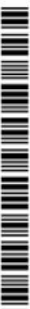
