It is often forgotten that
Our Lady of Fatima
requested the First
Saturday Devotion to be
widely observed to ensure
Russia's conversion. The
consecration which

recently took place by Pope Francis was not the only
requirement for the conversion of Russia, according to Our
Lady of Fatima. She included the request for the observance of
the First Saturday devotion. She said to Sister Lucia (one of the
three children at Fatima): "When you see a night illumined by
an unknown light, know that this is the great sign given you by
God that He is about to punish the world for its crimes, by
means of war, famine, and persecutions of the Church and of
the Holy Father. To prevent this, I shall come to ask for the
consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, and the
Communion of reparation on the First Saturdays. If my requests
are heeded, Russia will be converted, and there will be peace; if
not, she will spread her errors throughout the world, causing
wars and persecutions of the Church."

What is the First Saturday Devotion?

Our Lady of Fatima revealed to Sister Lucia the following
aspects of the First Saturday devotion:

- ❖ Receive Holy Communion on five consecutive First Saturdays
- ❖ Go to confession each month
- ❖ Recite five decades of the Rosary on the First Saturdays
- ❖ Meditate for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary.

Dear Parishioners:

I am pleased to present a summary report of our financial statements for the last fiscal year, July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024. This summary report is based on the complete report sent to the Finance Office of the Diocese of Arlington. Also, our independent accountant and our Parish Finance Council have reviewed all the parts of the report.

Last fiscal year, we ended with an operating surplus for the Church. On the other hand, the School ended with an operating deficit. Nevertheless, we are in good shape.

Regarding the loan, we paid down the principal about \$231,000, leaving a remaining balance of \$2,637,000 (as of June 30). Each month we pay \$30,000 (of which is about \$8,000 in interest) to the Diocese.


I also have other good news to share: The PTO raised \$425,000 for a new turf field, which will be installed behind the school. Since we do not need all of that space for parking, the PTO and school administration suggested we transform about one-half of it into a turf field for the students, so that they do not have to play only on the asphalt. We are awaiting the building permit from the county, which hopefully will happen soon.

Also, we will be creating a memorial garden where the new outdoor Stations of the Cross have been installed by Ben Cruley for his Eagle Scout project. This garden will have engraved bricks with names of our deceased loved ones. Here we will also include the names of the children who were memorialized previously in what was the old narthex of the church which was demolished for the entryway. Further details will be provided for those who wish to include their loved ones.

I thank you for your generosity shown through our regular offertory donations and any extra monthly contribution for "Debt Reduction." Please know that since my appointment as Pastor in June, 2020, I have strived to be a good steward for you and the parish. Given our economy and inflation, I understand the burden you all face, especially since I am responsible for my mom's care. Please understand our burden, particularly in providing fair wages for our staff. If possible, I ask you to consider prayerfully increasing your regular giving to help us meet the needs of your spiritual home.

Please be assured of my prayers.
