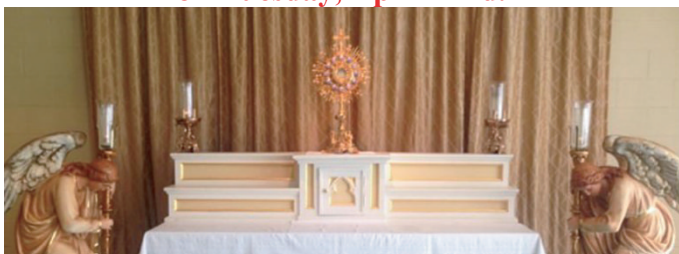

All Catholics are obliged to fast and abstain from meat on Good Friday. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinance from meat is obligatory from age 14 onwards.

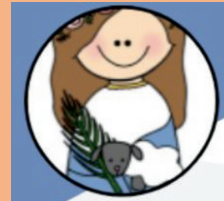
