Dear Parishioners,

“Jesus Christ is risen! Alleluia!” This Easter proclamation truly resonates as we continue our Holy Year Jubilee celebration. Pope Francis said that we are pilgrims of hope. Indeed, we have a hope that cannot be vanquished. The tomb is empty. Jesus—the Son of God, Lord, and Savior—has conquered sin, death, and evil itself. 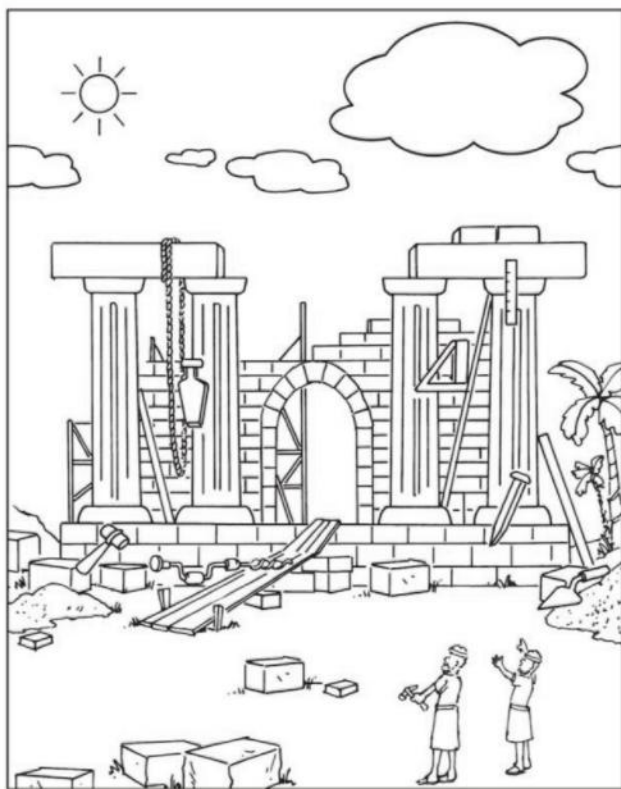


