

Dear Parishioners:

I am pleased to present a summary report of our financial statements for the last fiscal year, July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025. The complete report has been submitted to the Finance Office of the Diocese of Arlington, and was first reviewed by our independent accountant and Parish Finance Council.

Last fiscal year, we ended with a net surplus for the Church. We paid down the principal on the construction loan about \$273,000, leaving a remaining balance of \$2,364,454 (as of June 30). Our monthly payment is \$30,000 (of which is about \$8,000 in interest) to the Diocese.

On the other hand, the School ended with net deficit, due to \$800,000 in expenditures, which included a new roof, new windows, and the turf field. Keep in mind that in the last fiscal year, the school PTO had raised \$425,000 for the turf field; therefore, the parish did not incur that cost. Nevertheless, we are in good shape.

While the parish campus has received great attention in the last five years, my focus now is on the spiritual infrastructure. We want to build a spiritual community where people will be strengthened and energized in their faith. Besides the many long-standing groups and ministries, the parish now has its own Knights of Columbus Council, a Seniors Group, and Bible studies, including one for young adults (single, married, and married with children). If you have any suggestions about how we can build a stronger spiritual community, I would like to hear them. Moreover, consider how you can help.

In sum, I thank you for your generosity shown through our regular offertory donations and any extra monthly contribution for "Debt Reduction." Since my appointment as Pastor in June, 2020, I have strived to be a good steward for you and the parish. Given our economy and inflation, I understand the burden you all face. Please understand our burden, particularly in providing fair wages and benefits for our staff. If possible, I ask you to consider prayerfully increasing your regular giving to help us meet the needs of your spiritual home. In reality, one-third of the parish provides two-thirds of our operating revenue, and one-third has no record of giving. We need your help.
