Epiphany Blessing this Sunday, January 4th



To celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, we will have the blessing of holy water and chalk for the blessing of your homes after the 11:00 a.m. Mass this Sunday, January 4th.

(Please note holy water and chalks will be provided)

Blessing of the Homes: The Epiphany is the traditional time to have your home blessed by a priest for the New Year. If it isn't possible for a priest to come, the head of the household can preside over the ceremony, which includes prayers and sprinkling the rooms with holy water specially blessed for Epiphany.

Prayer:

*Lord God of heaven and earth,
you revealed your only-begotten Son to every nation
by the guidance of a star.*

*Bless this house
and all who inhabit it.*

*Fill them (us) with the light of Christ,
that their (our) concern for others may reflect your love.
We ask this through Christ our Lord.*

AMEN

After the ritual, mark the entryway of the home with chalk (see further explanation below).

Blessing of Chalk: In the blessing of the homes, you use blessed chalk to mark the doorways. The long-standing Epiphany tradition of marking churches, homes, schools, and other buildings with a special "holy formula" over the entryway follows a formula similar to the blessing of the Paschal Candle at Easter. This formula for Epiphany includes the current year along with the initials C, M, and B in the order shown below.

20 + C + M + B + 26

The C, M, and B are placed in between the numbers of the current year, with crosses in between each symbol. The three letters have two significations: the invocation Christus Mansionem Benedicat ("Christ bless this house"), as well as the first initial of the names of the three Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar.

Concluding Prayer:

*May Christ Jesus dwell with us,
keep us from all harm,
and make us one in mind and heart,
now and forever.*

AMEN



What does it mean to be an “active Catholic”?

An active Catholic embraces the teachings of the Catholic Church contained in the Word of God and in Sacred Tradition, and strives to live them. An active Catholic is registered in the parish, supports the mission of the Church with time, talent, and treasure, whether by worshipping at Holy Mass each Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation (except for illness or emergency), volunteering to serve the parish community in various ways, and supporting the parish financially, using Faith Direct or offertory envelopes. Active Catholic spouses and parents seek to help their loved ones know Jesus through prayer, Holy Mass, regular Penance, religious education, and charitable works.

Why is this important? Anyone who seeks to be a godparent or sponsor for the Sacraments of Baptism or Confirmation, or enter the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony, or receive a Catholic Tuition Rate at School must first be verified as an active Catholic and parishioner.




