

Lent Is Starting!

Ash Wednesday, February 18th: Masses and the distribution of ashes will be offered at **6:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m., Noon, and 7:00 p.m.** All Catholics are obliged to fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Also, Friday of Lent is a day of abstinence. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence from meat is obligatory from age 14 onwards.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed every Friday of Lent at 7:00 p.m.
