

Under this title Our Lady is known as the protectress of the Russian city of Kostroma. The icon of her there, *Our Lady of St. Theodore of Kostroma*, dates from the tenth century.

Lenten Observance

All Catholics are obliged to fast and abstain from meat on Good Friday. Also, Friday of Lent is a day of abstinence. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence from meat is obligatory from age 14 onwards.




