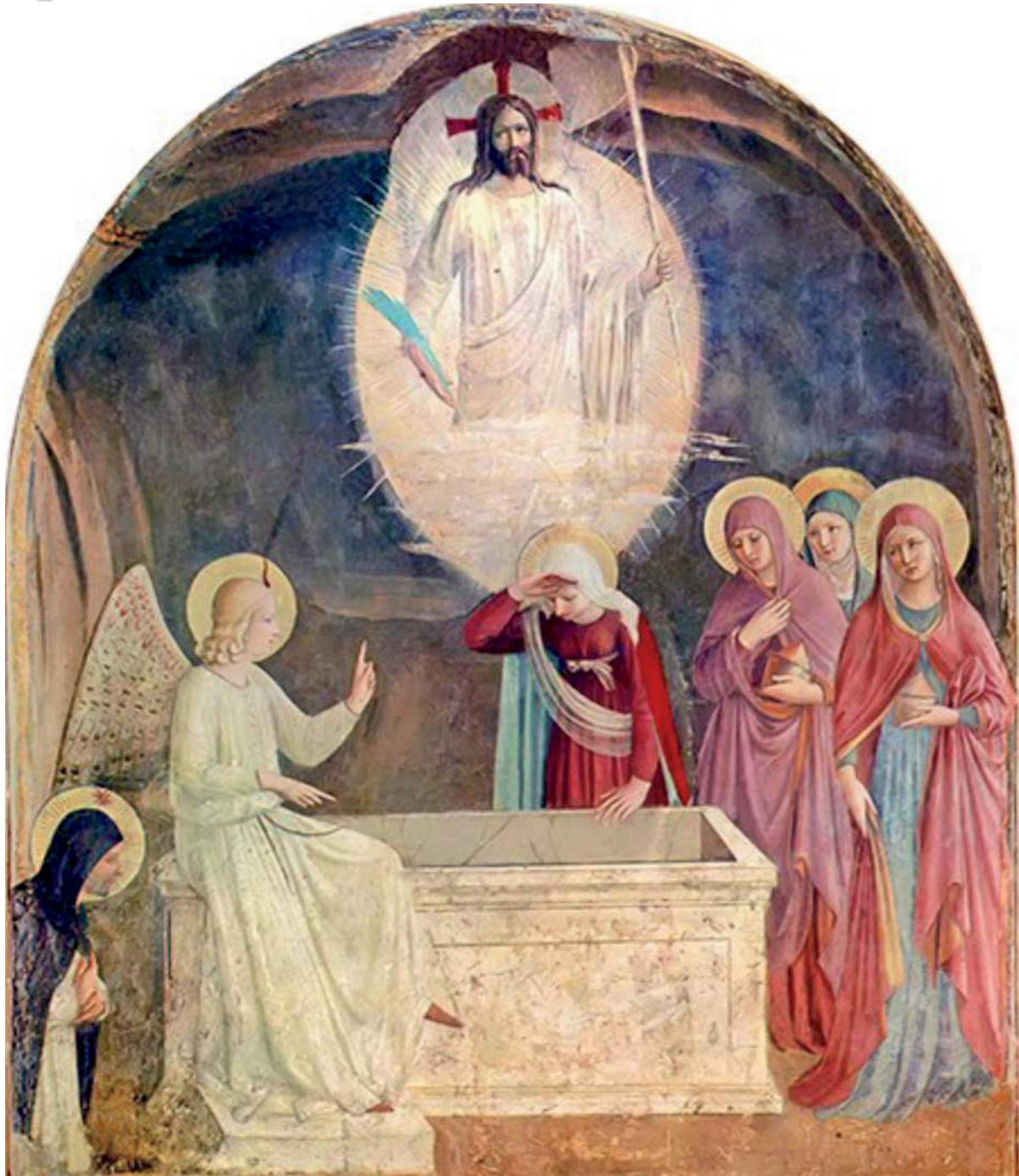

Please note: the field trip that was tentatively scheduled for this date has been postponed to later in the year.

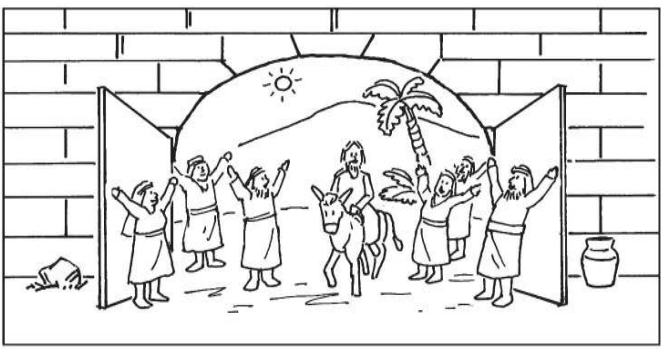
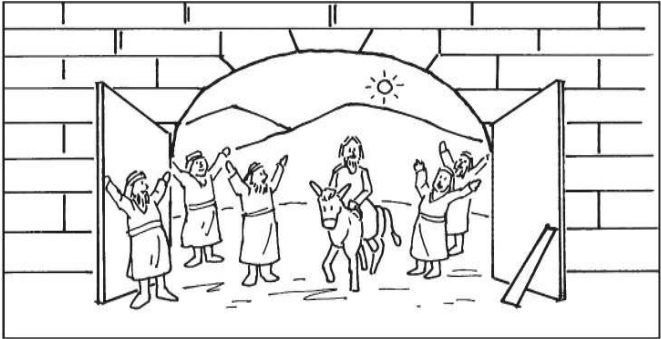
